The Global Cleantech Cluster Association is pleased to announce its Global Top 30 for the 2014 Later Stage Awards.

The GCCA Later Stage Award Top 30 semi-finalists and Top 10 winners are selected from an original pool of 10,000 eligible companies represented by the GCCA's 52 member clusters. Each cluster conducts internal evaluations to nominate up to 10 companies in the 10 categories. In total, these member clusters nominated over 100 companies for the 2014 Later Stage Award. That number was later narrowed to the Global Top 30 semi-finalists and the Top 10 winners.

A panel of Cleantech venture capitalists, investors and serial entrepreneurs who collectively manage \$3.5 billion in clean technology investment, will now judge the final 10 winners and one Grand Prize winner. The announcement is scheduled at the 5th annual Cleantech Investing Seminar in Lausanne (EPFL), Switzerland on December 3, 2014.

"The 2014 Global Top 30 companies exhibit market strength, breakthrough innovation, and a competitive position for growth," said Dr. Peter Adriaens, Head Judge of the GCCA Later Stage Awards, developer of the Keystone Compact™ and associated scoring method, and CEO of the KeyStone Compact Group Ltd, a global strategy and investment-level business analytics company.
